



Clinical Review Criteria Related to HPV Vaccine – Gardasil and Cervarix

Gardasil and Cervarix -- vaccines that help protect against cervical cancer, abnormal and precancerous cervical lesions, abnormal and precancerous vagina lesions, abnormal and precancerous vulvar lesions and genital warts, all caused by Human Papillomavirus (HPV). This vaccine will help prevent these diseases, but is not meant to treat them. At present, the vaccine is recommended for girls/women 9-26 years of age, to be given in three doses: initial, 2 months after initial, and 6 months after initial dose.
